

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE GREENVET4U PROJECT ARE:

Project partners will cocreate a set of innovative training contents and digital supported tools to upskill Ugandan VET practitioners and incompany trainers, target users of the project, to Design and Delivery Innovative Curricula in Skills for Green Jobs. They will test their skills during the project adapting the design of innovative curricula to the eco-tourism and waste-management related jobs, providing in-company work-based learning experiences to young people, women and migrants from unprivileged communities in Uganda, target beneficiaries of the project, to test innovative practices to prepare learners and VET providers to become true agents of change and create inclusive environments that foster equity and equality, and that are responsive to the needs of the wider community.

PROJECT RESULTS

The project develops the following concrete results

- A virtual collaborative space and innovation lab to support the activity of a Community of Practice of VET providers and practitioners of Uganda, Spain, Germany, Italy and other EU Member States.
- A Competences Matrix on Design and Delivery of Innovative Curricula in Skills for Green Jobs.
- A Training Programme addressed to Ugandan VET practitioners and in-company trainers to upskill their competences to design sector and job specific curricula for green jobs, to be delivered in both VET centres and high-quality inclusive workbased learning programmes in companies and other non-for-profit entities.
- A multifunctional Online Platform to support online training provision and management and provide access to information and resources.
- A WebApp solution to support the assessment and validation of learning outcomes in VET and the certification of Micro-credentials.
- Guidelines for Validation, Certification and Accreditation of Skills for Green Jobs through Micro-credentials, a document of reference for VET practitioners, authorities and policy makers.
